2026 PRACTICE ATTIRE REQUIREMENTS AND FEES

Dear Group members, parents, and guardians,

Since our inception in 2002, we have made it clear to all members that the practice attire colors are **strictly BLACK & OR WHITE**. Believe it or not, we take this **VERY SERIOUSLY**. This means that you can wear a black or white T-shirt with a Black or white short, or pant. The attire is to be accompanied by a comfortable pair of sneakers which can be any color of your choosing.

We have provided the option to purchase White and/or Black PHCMDC T-shirts with the following order deadlines:

- **Sunday, November 30th, 2025**
- **Tuesday, December 30th, 2025**
- **Saturday, January 31st, 2025**

All Practice T-shirt orders should be placed via our Shop tab on the website www.phcmdc.com and an online transfer to the uniform account 4010046347. Non-members are also welcome to purchase should they choose to support the group. Each order takes approximately 3 weeks to receive, so we advise you to order early to receive your attire when the term begins. Sizes available are Youth Small (YS) to Adult 4XL.

School clothes and shoes are **NOT** acceptable practice attire, along with Crocs and Flip Flops. **Sneakers ONLY!** Should you not have your required attire, you will be charged an ***out-of-uniform fee of \$5***, which is payable by the following practice date. A register is taken of all those who have been out of uniform for the term, with all fees of offenders to be paid to the same uniform account mentioned above.

Please organize yourselves every Monday night to ensure your bags are packed and ready with your Black and white attire. Those who consistently come to practices out of attire will be asked to sit on the sidelines, or return to practice with the appropriate attire as requested.




See the examples below of acceptable attire.
